### TNL UGANDA TEAM

A team from TNL (Greg & Lauren Owen, Jared Mackey, and Matt Paulsen) will be in Uganda Oct 19 - Nov 2 to work alongside the grassroots non-profit Come, Let's Dance. TNL has sent several teams to Uganda and currently Jennie Otte and Morgan Johnson, who have attended TNL, are both working full-time with CLD. The team will be visiting the CLD Children's Home that provides care for over 40 children as well as sponsoring two projects:

1. The Farm – A self-sustaining agricultural and livestock center that will include fish ponds, poultry houses, and housing for workers and staff. One of the initial aspects of infrastructure needed is a tree line to protect the land from intruders. Cost - \$2,000.00
2. Village Outreach – Travel with the Ugandan CLD staff on a 2-day village outreach that includes relief projects, delivery of resources, assessment of needs, and a village wide celebration meal. Cost - \$1,000.00
